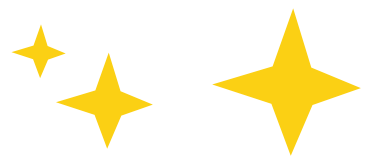

HOW TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT

To make appointments, phone the office to speak with Ava during office hours. You can also make non-urgent appointments via our website, www.frontierkidscare.com.

HOW TO MAKE QUERIES

Health queries are taken by Ava and relayed to Lisa, our nurse, between the hours of 12 noon to 2:00 pm on Mondays to Fridays, and 11:30 am to 12 noon on Saturdays. Calls will be relayed to Dr. Thomas as needed.

PAGES

Pages which are considered to be non-urgent will be answered the following day.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

For urgent calls or emergencies

Daytime: Call the office @ 645-9605.

You can speak with Lisa, who will relay your information to Dr. Thomas.

After Hours or Holidays: You can page Dr. Thomas @ 900-BEEP (2337).

A word about contacting us by pager. Pages will be answered depending on the urgency, which is assessed by Dr. Thomas. It is important that the messages are sent as follows:

- State your name
- State your child's first and last name and age
- Give a brief message as to why you are paging
- Leave a contact number so that we can get back to you
